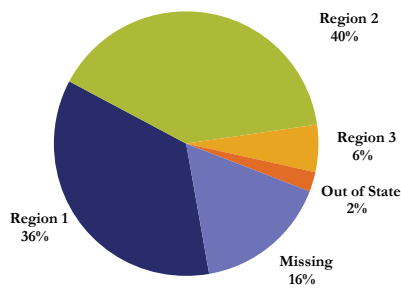

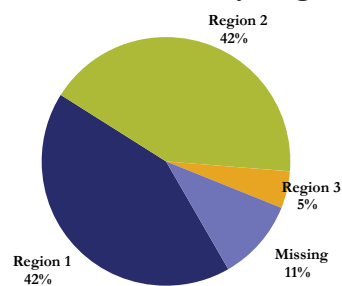

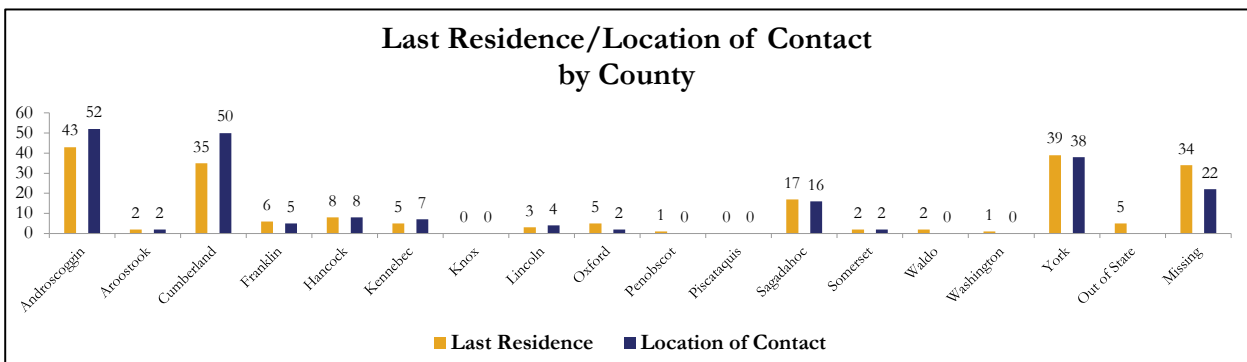
Last Residence by Region

Unstably Housed:

- Is living in the home of another because of economic hardship.
- Has been notified in writing of eviction within 21 days.
- Lives in a hotel or motel that they or a family member is paying for.
- Is leaving a health-care facility, mental health facility, foster care or other youth facility.

Literally Homeless (HUD's definition):

- An individual or family sleeping in a place not usually meant for humans including a car, park, abandoned building, bus or train station, airport, or camp ground.
- An individual or family living in a homeless shelter or hotel/motel paid for by an agency, program or charitable organization; congregate shelters or transitional housing.

¹ Geographically, Region 1 equals Cumberland and York counties; Region 2 equals Androscoggin, Franklin, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Sagadahoc, Somerset and Waldo counties; Region 3 equals Aroostook, Hancock, Penobscot, Piscataquis, and Washington counties.
