

DOE BUY AMERICA, BUILD AMERICA (BABA) SELF-CERTIFICATION

(contractor name, hereinafter known as "Contractor") must
comply with the requirements of the Section 70914 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, and all applicable rule and notices, as may be amended. Pursuant to DOE's Memorandum, reissued February 23, 2024, "Weatherization Assistance Program "Build America, Buy America" Requirements – Revised", awards made by the DOE Weatherization Assistance Program after May 14, 2022 are subject to BABA requirements, unless excepted by a waiver. This only applies to weatherization on public housing or on privately owned buildings that serve a public function.
The Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) requires that all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used for federally funded infrastructure projects are produced in the United States, unless otherwise exempt or subject to an approved waiver. Please see the MaineHousing Build America, Buy America Policy for more information.
For all projects subject to BABA, the Contractor will submit the DOE Build America, Buy America Construction Material Spreadsheet and certify, to the best of his/her knowledge and belief (check all that apply):
