**This MaineHousing Notice # 2025-HARP-002 is being issued to clarify the program requirement that all eligible Home Repair and Older Adult Home Repair projects must be weatherized via MaineHousing’s Weatherization program, within 6 months of completion of a HARP project.**

- Added language to the HARP Program Guidance stating that WAP eligible households must be weatherized after receiving grants for Home Repair or Older Adult Home Repair.**

**HARP Guide Changes:**

**Section B3.C.1.a.iv. Changes:**

**TO** – "If a household is eligible for weatherization after home repair activities are completed, the home must be weatherized via MaineHousing’s Weatherization Program. The Weatherization job must be completed within six months of the HARP project being completed."
