This MaineHousing Notice is being issued to provide clarification to CAAs on HARP project expenses and their connection to HARP allocations.

## 1. HARP Project Expense Fees

**HARP project expenses** Project-related expenditures under the HARP program — such as registry filing fees, septic design fees, and walk-away fees — are considered allowable administrative costs. The funding required to cover these expenses is included in each Community Action Agency's (CAA's) total HARP funding allocation. All HARP project costs, with the exception of water testing, are incorporated into this overall allocation. To assist CAAs in accurately reconciling their grant funding, MaineHousing's monthly status reports include a dedicated column for project expenses, fees, and walk-away costs.
