1. Central Heating Improvement Program

Reference: MaineHousing CHIP Guidance, section 6 B.2 – Use of Funds.

CHIP Consent Form – The following has been added “(3) I understand that any parts, components or heating system(s) that are replaced in my home will be removed from the premises by the vendor.”
