**This MaineHousing Notice is being issued to provide an update regarding PY2025 TANF Supplemental Fuel Assistance Credits.**

### **1. PY2025 TANF SUPP Benefit Update**

The PY2025 TANF Supplemental Assistance Benefit has been set at \$300.00. The Benefit amount is based upon the number of participants authorized as well as the funding available.

MaineHousing has received authorization to issue Credit Notifications for PY2025 TANF Supplemental Benefits. These will be issued to Vendors on Friday, September 26, 2025. Client Credit Notifications will be sent to clients on Friday, October 3, 2025.

As a reminder, PY2025 HEAP Benefits **must** be exhausted prior to or in conjunction with PY2025 TANF credits.

PY2025 TANF Supplemental Benefit credits may be applied to eligible deliveries through April 30, 2026.
