Happy end of January!

Amidst the challenges of the last months, one bright spot was attending the opening of Furman Block.

The new development adds 40 affordable units and 11 market rate units to Portland's tight real estate market. Six of the affordable units are set aside to house people who were homeless - with the opening of the development, they will have a place to call their own.

We're proud to support efforts like these that not only add to the number of affordable units in places where they are desperately needed, but also adds to this community's character and the sense of community in this neighborhood.

With the vast majority of our staff telecommuting once more, we are hard at work on standing up the new rent relief program (more below), gearing up for the legislative session, and of course making sure our long-standing programs are running as smoothly and efficiently as possible. New Emergency Shelter Hotels

Our COVID-19 response continues with contracting with more hotels to accommodate emergency shelter needs. We have new emergency shelter contracts with hotels in Waterville (29 rooms, combination of families and singles), Scarborough (73 rooms, all singles), and Presque Isle (10 rooms, families and singles).

We appreciate the work that has gone into standing up these emergency shelters, especially from our partners at Mid-Maine Homeless Shelter, the City of Portland and Preble Street, and the Aroostook County Action Program. The new hotel emergency shelters are in addition to similar efforts in South Portland, Lewiston, and Bangor.

Our COVID-19 Response

MaineHousing has been central to Maine's response to keeping Mainers housed throughout the COVID-19 pandemic.

Our multifaceted response began with funding homeless shelter providers with additional operations funding to address COVID-19 concerns, to house homeless individuals in hotels, and to launch wellness shelters. We quickly expanded our response to fund the COVID-19 Rent Relief Program. <u>This document</u> outlines costs and some of the outcomes of our work.

MaineHousing Publishes 2020 Maine Homeownership Affordability Index

Each year, MaineHousing publishes a homeownership affordability index detailing the affordability of homeownership for those at the local median income.
