Over 50,000 Maine people working in over 7,000 Maine businesses are involved in the housing industry.





Residential housing is a major sector of Maine's economy. Every time a house is built, there is work at wood mills and plumbing installers, law offices and real estate agencies, furniture stores and moving companies, land-scapers and banks. 50,000 Maine people work in residential housing and its related sectors, or around 10% of the workforce (see next page).

The decline of home values hurts the ability of homeowners to spend on big ticket items like education and automobiles and furniture. The health of Maine's housing industry is not just a concern for a few builders.

It matters to everyone.
